

Make your little green button **WORK FOR YOU**

Don't want the button to show on your desktop, but still want it there for peace of mind?

No problem! You can minimise the button so that it only shows in your notification bar.

- 1 Right-click your button
- 2 Select 'Settings' from the menu
- 3 Under the 'Appearance' tab, click 'show in notification area only'.

Not discreet enough?

Set up customer keyboard shortcuts instead.

- 1 Right-click your button
- 2 Select 'Settings' from the menu
- 3 Under the 'Options' tab, select which combination of keys you'd like to use.

Example: **F1 + Ctrl + Alt**

To summon assistance, just press you desired key combination three times in quick succession.



Hint!

You can also change the transparency settings of the button under the 'Appearance' tab - make it as solid or as see-through as you need!

Want to make sure an alert never gets missed?

Add sound.

- 1 Right-click your button
- 2 Select 'Settings' from the menu
- 3 Under the 'Options' tab, tick 'Audible alert on this computer when a colleague requests assistance?'.



Did you know?

We also offer physical panic buttons that can be plugged in to your device's USB port - they're discreet, and allow you to use the system even when your device is locked!
